RE: CANCELLATION OF CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY  
FOR COGENT COMMUNICATIONS OF ARIZONA, INC.  
DOCKET NO. T-03871A-00-0277

On April 27, 2000, Allied Riser of Arizona, Inc. ("Allied") filed an application to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange telecommunication services in Arizona. On November 16, 2000, Allied was granted a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide facilities based and resold local exchange telecommunication services in Arizona by Decision No. 63147. By Procedural Order, dated May 7, 2001, Allied was granted an extension to file its plans to publish and include customers' telephone numbers in incumbents' directories and directory assistance databases.

In a letter dated July 11, 2002, Allied filed a letter in which it notified the Arizona Corporation Commission that the Company granted a CC&N in Decision No. 63147 is also legally known as Cogent Communications of Arizona, Inc. ("Cogent"). On November 22, 2002, Staff filed a Motion in which it requested that all administrative steps be taken to note the additional name of Cogent in this Docket.

In response to a February 28, 2007 Staff email inquiry, Cogent provided a copy of a Certificate of Compliance for Dissolution Corporate Dissolution or Withdrawal issued by the Arizona Department of Revenue.

Since being granted its CC&N and the requested extension, Cogent, f/k/a Allied, has failed to provide a performance bond and submit tariffs as ordered by Decision No. 63147. Additionally, Cogent informed Staff in a February 28, 2007 email that telecommunications services were never provided in Arizona and the Applicant has ceased to exist.

Staff recommends that Cogent's CC&N be cancelled. Upon cancellation of its CC&N, Cogent will no longer be authorized to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange

telecommunication services in the State of Arizona. Therefore, Cogent will no longer be subject to the requirements of Decision No. 63147.
