

interested persons may
intervene in the proceedings
and participate as a party. You
may have the rights to
intervene in the proceeding.
Intervention will be in
accordance with A.A.G. R14-
3-105, except that all motions
to intervene must be filed on
or before June 4, 2007.
Persons desiring to intervene
must file a written motion to
intervene with the Commission
and send such motion to
Applicant or its counsel and to
all parties of record. The
motion must, at the minimum,
contain the following:

1. The name, address, and
telephone number of the
proposed intervenor and of
any party upon whom service
of documents is to be made if
different from that of the
intervenor.

2. A short statement of the
proposed intervenor's interest
in the proceeding (e.g., a
customer or potential
customer of the Applicant, a
member or shareholder of the
Applicant, etc.).

3. A statement certifying that a
copy of the motion to
intervene has been mailed to
the Applicant or its counsel
and to all parties of record in
the case.

The granting of intervention,
among other things, entitles a
party to present sworn
evidence at the hearing and to
cross-examine other
witnesses. However, failure to
intervene will not preclude any
interested person or entity
from appearing at the hearing

and providing public comment
on the applications. You will
not receive any further notice
of this proceeding unless you
request it. Comments may
also be made by writing to the
