**EXCEPTIONS OF ARIZONA
PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY
TO STAFF'S RECOMMENDED
ORDER**

Arizona Public Service Company (hereinafter "APS" or "Company") hereby submits to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") the following exceptions to Staff's recommended Order, submitted on April 25, 2007, regarding APS's Application for Commission approval of its Schedule 8 bill estimation filing ("Recommended Order").

No change in APS's energy estimation procedures was required by Decision No. 68112 nor by the Settlement Agreement approved in that Decision. Nevertheless, if the Commission finds that it is otherwise appropriate for APS to revise its current energy estimation methodology, APS does not object to doing so, but requests that the Commission allow APS to simultaneously implement both the revised demand and energy estimation methodologies at once, rather than splitting the deadline as Staff recommends. Reprogramming the Customer Information System to implement the combined demand and energy estimation procedures is time-consuming, and a single deadline for implementing both procedures is needed for APS to efficiently do both. APS therefore asks that the Commission give APS seven months after the Commission's approval of this matter – until December 31, 2007 – to implement both estimation procedures, which is consistent with the period called for by the Settlement Agreement and Ordered in Decision No. 68112 with reference to just the changes in demand estimation.

3 Also, in the revised Schedule 8 that APS provided to Staff and that Staff attached to
4 its Report, there were some typographical errors.¹ Upon approval of this Schedule, the
5 Company will file a corrected version.

APS PROPOSED AMENDMENT #1

DELETE: page 9, lines 18-22

REPLACE WITH:

“IT IS FURTHER ORDERED APS shall implement the demand (kW) and energy (kWh) estimation methodologies, as approved by the Commission in this proceeding, by December 31, 2007. The Company shall docket (as a compliance item in this matter) a letter, within 15 days of the implementation, stating that the implementation is complete.
