We respectfully request that you support us as important property owners and the La Paz County Supervisors that stated in their decision "that Allegheny give deep concern and attention to your rights, needs and concerns" And that they cooperate with us as to our request that no Transmission lines be closer than one mile from said interchange.


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

La Paz Generating Facility


