IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF PINNACLE WEST CAPITAL CORPORATION FOR AN ORDER OR ORDERS AUTHORIZING IT TO GUARANTEE THE INDEBTEDNESS OF ARIZONA PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY

**REQUEST OF ARIZONA PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY AND PINNACLE WEST CAPITAL CORPORATION FOR DELAY IN ISSUANCE OF A PROCEDURAL ORDER IN THE ABOVE CAPTIONED MATTER**

Arizona Public Service Company ("APS" or the "Company") and Pinnacle West Capital Corporation ("Pinnacle West"), co-applicants herein, hereby request that the Hearing Division delay the issuance of a Procedural Order setting an evidentiary hearing in this matter. Although APS did, on May 25, 2007, submit comments on the Utilities Division Staff Report (the "Staff Report"), which was filed in the above docket on May 18, 2007, the Company took no substantive objection to the Staff Report. Rather the Company sought clarification and definition of certain of the Staff's recommendations.

1 APS and Staff will be meeting on June 27, 2007 so that APS can better understand the  
2 recommendations contained within such Report.

3 Given the timing constraints identified in the Company's original Application of  
4 December 15, 2006 and the very distinct possibility that there are no substantive issues of  
5 disagreement between Staff and APS/Pinnacle West (the only parties to this docket), a  
6 hearing in this proceeding may prove inappropriate and unnecessary. In point of fact, the  
7 Staff Report of May 18 did *NOT* request such a hearing. For these reasons, APS and  
8 Pinnacle West ask that the Hearing Division delay issuing a Procedural Order setting an  
9 evidentiary hearing until further notice from either Staff or the Company.
