Page 12, Line 17 INSERT new Findings of Fact:

“36. The Commission disagrees with the Committee and finds that SCE should be fined for its failure to comply with the lawful orders of the Commission. Upholding the Committee’s decision to impose no remedies would be unfair to utilities that comply with Commission orders and Arizona law.

37. The Commission disagrees with Staff’s proposed fine of \$4.8 million. The range permitted under A.R.S. § 40-424 is from \$912,500 to \$45,625,000 based on daily non-compliance from 1981 until 2006. The appropriate penalty supported by the record in this case is \$1.75 million.¹”

Page 13, Line 18 DELETE “not”

Page 13, Line 18 DELETE “nor” and INSERT “and”

Page 13, Line 25 INSERT new Ordering Paragraph:

“IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that SCE shall pay a fine of \$1.75 million for its violation of Decision Nos. 49226 and 51170 by the construction of double-circuit towers as part of DPV1.”
