PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On July 28, 2006, Arizona-American Water Company ("Arizona-American" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an increase in its rates for utility service by its Sun City Wastewater and Sun City West Wastewater Districts.

By Procedural Order issued February 15, 2007, the hearing in this matter was scheduled to commence on August 23, 2007, and associated procedural deadlines were set.

On June 11, 2007, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Rate Design Testimony. Staff requested a two week extension of time due to other work load obligations and illness, and stated that it does not believe any party will be prejudiced by its request.

No objections were filed.

Staff's request is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that that Staff shall file direct testimony and associated exhibits to be presented at hearing on its behalf regarding rate design on or before **June 27, 2007**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all remaining procedural deadlines remain unchanged.
