RE: ADEQ noncompliance issues

This is regarding the noncompliance issues noted in the Recommended Opinion and Order for DOCKET NO. W-02526A-07-0170 on page 6, #27, that is scheduled for Open Meeting on June 26 and 27, 2007. As stated by #27, the effective date of the \$30.00 interim gallonage charge shall be delayed until the first day of the month following the Company meeting: "that the Company files with Docket Control as a compliance item in this docket, documentary evidence that it is taking steps to resolve its' noncompliance with ADEQ regulations to Staff satisfaction."

Bellefont Water Company has been working with ADEQ to get into compliance. The following are comments and/or status of each deficiency listed in the ADEQ Compliance Status Report, dated March 29, 2007:

1. Maximum Residual Disinfection Levels- Also, the chlorine levels are checked monthly along with the monthly testing.
2. Disinfection Byproducts Analysis- This is another mentioned deficiency. This test can only be done in our hottest month, which will be in August. It is out of our hands until August when it will be performed.
3. Lead and Copper Monitoring- Another mentioned deficiency. The first part of the testing has been completed, and a repeat of this test is to be performed in 6 months' time. Thereafter it needs to be repeated once a year.
4. Total Coliform and Fecal Coliform Analysis: E- coli and total coliform testing is done on a monthly basis. December was skipped, but ADEQ requires 6 consecutive negative testing months, and we are upon this now.

If there are any questions regarding the testing and/or results you can call Western Technologies and talk to Gary who is the operator for our system at 928.774.8700. As a reminder, we purchased the shares of Bellefont Water in September of 2006. At this time it was too late for the second test mentioned. The lead and copper was never followed up by the previous owners. Meanwhile, our monthly testing is being performed and testing negative for coliform and e-coli.
