**STAFF'S REQUEST FOR A SUSPENSION  
OF THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On December 12, 2006, Golden Shores Water Company ("Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for the approval of long-term debt. On February 23, 2007, the Company filed an application with the Commission for an increase in its rates and charges. The proceedings were eventually consolidated.


The Staff issued two notices of insufficiency on March 26, 2007 and May 11, 2007, respectively. On May 30, 2007, Staff filed a letter indicating that the Company's rate application was sufficient.

The Commission issued a Procedural Order on June 7, 2007, which established a procedural schedule in this case.

The Company has told Staff recently that they need additional time to assemble supporting information requested by Staff in its first set of data requests. They have also indicated that because of the additional time that they will need to respond, they would not object to a suspension of the procedural schedule at this time.

1 Therefore, Staff respectfully requests a suspension of the procedural schedule until such time  
2 as Staff notifies the ALJ that it has received full and complete responses to its outstanding data  
3 requests so that it may continue its processing of this case.
