

**Request for Commission Amendment to Decision 66510**

Midvale Telephone Exchange hereby requests that the Arizona Corporation Commission (Commission) amend its Decision 66510.

Midvale originally planned to serve the Poquito subdivision by locating a receiving microwave radio tower in the subdivision. However, the residents objected to the placement of the tower. Rather than attempt to obtain permission for placement of the tower from the Yavapai County Planning and Zoning Commission and from the Arizona Corporation Commission over the residents' objections, the Company has opted to instead install underground cable from our switch in Dewey to the Poquito subdivision.

Therefore Midvale has not, and will not, be obtaining the tower and right of way permits that are the subject of the compliance requirement. Midvale currently has an application for RUS financing pending with the Commission, the funds of which will in part be used to install the underground cable necessary to serve the area.

Midvale respectfully requests the Commission amend Decision as follows. In Decision 66510, Staff recommended that Midvale be required to:


File a certification with the Director of the Utilities Division that all the required tower and right of way permits have been obtained within 365 days of the effective date of this Decision.

Decision 66510 at ¶17(c). The Commission adopted Staff's recommendation in its Order at page 13, lines 23-24, of the Decision. Midvale requests that the Commission amend Decision 66510 by amending page 13, lines 23-24 to read:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff's recommendations set forth in Findings of Fact No. 17, **except for Staff recommendation set forth in Findings of Fact No. 17(c), and** except as amended in Findings of Fact No. 20.
