On December 9, 2002, Matrix Telecom, Inc. ("Matrix") and International Exchange Communications, Inc. ("International") (collectively "Applicants") filed a joint application for approval of the transfer of certain assets and related transactions and a waiver of applicable anti-slamming regulations in the State of Arizona. The Application submitted is not sufficient. This data request lists the information Staff needs to complete its analysis of your Application.

For purposes of this data request set, the words "Applicants" and "Companies" refer to Matrix Telecom, Inc. and International Exchange Communications, Inc. and any representative, including every person and/or entity acting with, under the control of, or on behalf of Matrix Telecom, Inc. and International Exchange Communications, Inc. **For each answer, please identify by name, title, e-mail address, telephone number and address each person providing information that forms the basis for the response provided.**

These data requests are continuing, and your answers or any documents supplied in response to these data requests should be supplemented with any additional information or documents that come to your attention after you have provided your initial responses.

Please provide Docket Control with the information being requested within **20 days** of the date of this letter. Mail an Original plus 13 copies to Docket Control, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007-2927. If no response is received, Staff will recommend that the Application be terminated. If the Application is terminated, the Applicant cannot discontinue the telecommunications services that it is authorized to provide in Arizona, until such time as a new application is filed with and approved by the Commission.

How many customers did Matrix Telecom, Inc. ("Matrix") serve as of December 9, 2002 in Arizona? Identify the number of residential customers and business customers in Arizona that were served by Matrix as of December 9, 2002. How many IE Com customers were transferred to Matrix between January 4, 2001 and December 9, 2002? Identify the number of IE Com residential customers and business customers transferred to Matrix between to January 4, 2001 and December 9, 2002.
- JFB2-2 The Applicants filed their joint application on December 9, 2002. How many customers in Arizona did Matrix serve between December 9, 2002 and the last date that the last IE Com customer(s) was transferred to Matrix? Identify the number of residential customers and business customers in Arizona that were served between December 9, 2002 and the last date that the last IE Com customer(s) was transferred to Matrix. How many IE Com customers in Arizona were transferred to Matrix between December 9, 2002 and the last date that the last IE Com customer(s) was transferred to Matrix? - JFB 2-5 Attached to the August 25, 2004, letter was a copy of a Public Notice release from the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") that indicated that the acquisition of IE Com's assets by Matrix was granted on July 7, 2004. A copy of the notice, titled "Notice of Transfer of Long Distance Long Telephone Service", sent to IE Com's customers was attached to the August 25, 2004 letter. The transition was scheduled to occur on or shortly after April 15, 2004. The customer notice date of the transition of April 15, 2004 is before the date the acquisition of IE Com's assets by Matrix was granted on July 7, 2004. What date did IE Com's assets transfer to Matrix? Please provide a copy of the customer notice sent to IE Com customers. Make sure the copy of the customer notice to IE Com customers shows the actual date the notice was sent. If there were more than one dated customer notices sent to IE Com customers, provide a copy of each dated notice.
- JFB2-6 According to the Application, International Exchange Communications, Inc. d/b/a IE Com ("IE Com") filed a voluntary petition under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code and ceased operations on January 4, 2001. Attached to the August 25, 2004, letter was a copy of a Public Notice release from the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") that indicated that the acquisition of IE Com's assets by Matrix was granted on July 7, 2004. How many customers in Arizona did Matrix serve as of January 4, 2001? Identify the number of residential customers and business customers in Arizona served by Matrix as of January 4, 2001. How many IE Com customers were transferred to Matrix between January 4, 2001 and July 7, 2004? JFB2-9 As of this writing, do all IE Com customers that were transferred to Matrix continue to receive service under the name of IE Com? Use rates and/or term of conditions of their services listed in IE Com tariffs? Have the name IE Com listed as their provider on their bills? If not, please explain the reason(s) the name is not used and provide the date the IE Com name was terminated.

JFB2-10 Staff received the Applicants' responses to Staff's first set of data requests on October 3, 2003. According to the Applicants' response to JFB1-3, IE Com customers were being served by Matrix under the Management Services Agreement ("MSA") that was executed on December 29, 2000. The MSA remains in effect until all regulatory approvals are obtained. Does the MSA remain in effect at this time? If not, please explain the reason(s) it is not in effect and provide the date the MSA was terminated. How many customers did Matrix Telecom, Inc. ("Matrix") serve as of December 29, 2000 in Arizona? Identify the number of residential customers and business customers in Arizona that were served by Matrix as of December 29, 2000. How many IE Com customers were transferred to Matrix prior to January 4, 2001? Identify the number of IE Com residential customers and business customers transferred to Matrix prior to January 4, 2001

JFB2-11 Have there been any changes in the rates and/or terms and conditions of service in IE Com's tariff that serves the transferred IE Com customers? If so, has Matrix notified all IE Com customers that transferred to Matrix of the tariff changes? If not, please explain the reason(s) it did not inform the transferred IE Com customers and provide the source documentation that allowed Matrix not to inform the IE Com customers of the tariff changes.
