**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

11 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

12 On April 28, 2006, IPC Network Services, Inc. ("IPC" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona  
 13 Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and  
 14 Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold point-to-point private line telecommunications services in  
 15 Arizona.

16 On June 5, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Letter of Insufficiency  
 17 and first set of data requests in this matter.

18 On July 5, 2006, IPC filed its response to the data request.

19 On June 4, 2007, IPC filed updated information in response to Staff's data requests.

20 On June 26, 2007, Staff filed its Staff Report recommending approval of IPC's application.

21 On October 19, 2007, by Procedural Order, this matter was set for hearing to begin on  
 22 November 29, 2007.

23 On November 23, 2007, IPC docketed proof of publication in accordance with the Procedural  
 24 Order issued in this matter. Subsequently, counsel for IPC contacted the Hearing Division stating the  
 25 Applicant would be requesting a continuance in this matter.

26 On November 29, 2007, a full public hearing was commenced before a duly authorized  
 27 Administrative Law Judge of the Commission at its offices in Phoenix, Arizona. Applicant failed to  
 28 appear; however, the hearing was commenced for the taking of public comments.


1 On November 29, 2007, Applicant filed a Motion to Continue the hearing. Subsequently, a  
2 Procedural Order was issued on December 7, 2007, which continued the hearing until January 22,  
3 2008.

4 On December 7, 2007, Staff filed a Staff Report Amendment, stating that it was no longer  
5 requesting a hearing be held in this matter.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant shall file a Response to the Staff Report  
7 Amendment, specifically addressing whether or not Applicant desires to have a hearing in this matter,  
8 no later than **January 11, 2008**.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon review of the Applicant's response, a determination  
10 will be made as to whether a hearing is necessary.
