PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On June 28, 2007, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 69672 which approved the application of West End Water Company ("Applicant" or "Company") for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide public water service to a 140 acre parcel contiguous to its certificated service area to be developed as a residential subdivision known as Walden Ranch which is being developed by Woodside Homes ("Woodside").

The Commission's Decision extending the Company's Certificate to provide service to Walden Ranch was conditioned upon the Company filing, by December 31, 2007, with the Commission's Docket Control, as a compliance item in this docket, a copy of the developer's Certificate of Assured Water Supply ("CAWS"), where applicable or when required by statute and a copy of the Maricopa County Environmental Services Department ("MCESD") Approval to Construct ("ATC").

On October 19, 2007, the Company filed a request for an extension with respect to the above-referenced conditions under an incorrect docket number, which was subsequently corrected with an amended filing on November 16, 2007, in the correct docket. The Company is requesting an extension of time in which to file copies of the developer's CAWS and the MCESD ATC until July 31, 2008, due to delays in the proceeding caused by intervener issues and the requirement of a supplemental hearing approximately four months after the initial hearing on the application. As a result, the Company believes that the previously authorized filing dates for the CAWS and the ATC

1 should be extended.

2 On December 7, 2007, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a memorandum  
3 which supports the Company's requested extension of its time to meet the filing dates established by  
4 Decision No. 69672 for the filing of copies of the developer's CAWS and the MCESD ATC by July  
5 31, 2008.

6 Accordingly, the Company should be granted an extension of time in which to file copies of  
7 the developer's CAWS and the MCESD ATC.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the West End Water Company shall have until July 31,  
9 2008, in which to file copies of the developer's Certificate of Assured Water Supply and the  
10 Maricopa County Environmental Service Department Approval to Construct as previously ordered in  
11 Decision No. 69672.
