

Pinal County and the communities adjacent to the Union Pacific Railroad are collectively addressing issues associated with the double track project. A Rail Corridor Study group was formed to work with Union Pacific throughout the process.

At this time, Pinal County supports UPRR's application to modify the public crossings at Rio Bravo and Ralston Roads as part of the double track project.
