
**MOTION TO AMEND FORM OF NOTICE**

**REVISED PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING**

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE APPLICATION OF ARIZONA  
AMERICAN WATER FOR A DETERMINATION OF THE CURRENT FAIR  
VALUE OF ITS UTILITY PLANT AND PROPERTY AND  
FOR INCREASES IN RATES AND CHARGES FOR UTILITY SERVICE IN SUN  
CITY WATER DISTRICT  
DOCKET NUMBER W-01303A-07-0209**

**Summary**

On April 2, 2007, Arizona American Water filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission for an increase in revenues for its **Sun City Water District** of approximately 29.53 percent (\$2,239,681). Arizona American Water's proposal would increase an average residential customer's bill for water service from the current rate of \$13.91 per month to \$18.04 per month (approximately 29.70 percent.) This is a total average monthly increase of \$4.13 per month, or about .14 cents per day, based on usage of 8,269 gallons per month.

Of course the actual increase for each customer would vary, based on the type and quantity of service provided. Customers may contact the Arizona American Water to inquire about the effect of the Company's request on their individual bill.

The Arizona Corporation Commission's Utilities Division Staff is in the process of auditing and analyzing Arizona American Water's records but has not yet made a recommendation regarding the proposed rate increase. The Residential Utility Consumer Office and the Sun City Taxpayers Association, Inc. are also parties to this proceeding. The Arizona Corporation Commission will determine the appropriate rate adjustment to be granted based on the evidence of record in the proceeding. The Arizona Corporation Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, or any intervenors and therefore, the final rates approved may differ from the rates proposed by the Company.

**Arizona Corporation Commission Public Hearing Information**

The Arizona Corporation Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning **January 7, 2008** at the Arizona Corporation Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. **About Intervener Status**

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you desire to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Arizona Corporation Commission no later than **October 1, 2007**. You must send a copy of the motion to intervene to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address and telephone number of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if not yourself.
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the application or from filing written comments in the record of the case. You will not receive any further notice of this proceeding unless you request it.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
