**MOTION TO INTERVENE OF  
WESTERN RESOURCE  
ADVOCATES**

16 Pursuant to the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Arizona Corporation Commission  
17 (Commission), Western Resource Advocates (WRA) hereby moves to intervene in the above-  
18 captioned docket and, in support thereof, states as follows:

19 1. WRA is a regional environmental law and policy center serving the Rocky  
20 Mountain and Desert Southwest states. WRA has been involved in proceedings before the  
21 Commission for over fifteen years and has been granted intervenor status in numerous dockets.  
22 As part of this work, WRA has represented a number of other Arizona non-profit organizations  
23 on energy issues.

24 2. WRA's Energy Program promotes policies and programs designed to encourage  
25 the development of clean energy power production technologies, energy  
efficiency, renewable resources, distributed generation, and other measures that

1 help reduce the environmental impacts of meeting the demand for energy services  
2 and encourage sustainable rural economic development, while minimizing the  
3 costs and risks to ratepayers of fuel price volatility and environmental regulatory  
4 requirements. It has appeared in rate proceedings before the Commission and in  
5 other state and federal regulatory forums to recommend, among other things,  
6 improvements in rate design for sending efficient price signals and cost recovery  
7 mechanisms for investments in renewable energy and energy efficiency.

8 3. WRA was a signatory to the settlement agreement adopted in Decision No.  
9 67744.

10 4. Intervention by WRA will not unduly broaden the issues or delay the proceeding.  
11 WRA does not yet know what position it will take, if any, in this proceeding.
