I.

The Distributed Energy Association of Arizona ("DEAA") hereby applies to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an Order granting it leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding.

II.

In support of the request to intervene in the above captioned docket, DEAA states as follows:

1. DEAA is an Arizona, member-based non-profit organization serving a diverse group of stakeholders in the industrial sector of on-site power generation and distributed energy. DEAA has been previously involved in a number of proceedings before the Commission before and has been granted intervenor status in various dockets over the

years. As part of this work, DEAA has represented the interests of many Arizona power users and utility ratepayers on energy issues.

2. DEAA's mission is to promote the efficient generation and use of distributed energy throughout Arizona. DEAA advocates for fair and reasonable pricing in the utility industry within the state and encourages the development of sustainable, clean and efficient power generation infrastructure. DEAA assists our members with the understanding and evaluation of various energy issues beyond on-site power, including but not limited to, energy efficiency, demand side management, interconnection, renewable energy, energy management system development and load analysis. DEAA's members may be impacted by derogation of the self-build option.

In order to represent its members' interest in building, installing, and operating onsite generation and distributed energy resources, the DEAA needs to examine the materials presented in the above-captioned docket as well as cross-examine witnesses appearing on behalf of the Company and related parties, if any. 
