

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

Livco Water Company has applied to the Arizona Corporation Commission for an increase in rates. The present rates have been in effect since June 2006. The present rates are based on a test year of 2004. Operating expenses have increased substantially in the past three years which necessitates a rate adjustment. The Company anticipates that the proposed rate design will not only cover increased operating expenses and continued plant maintenance, but encourage water conservation as well. Based on the Company's un-audited 2006 adjusted test year results, Livco Water Company's realized an operating loss of \$21,244. The Company is requesting a revenue increase of \$52,834 or 49.27 percent of total revenues. Please see reverse side of this notification for present and proposed rates.

The Application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix at 1200 West Washington Street, in Tucson at 400 West Congress, North Building, Room 218, and at Livco Water Company at #1 County Road 5100 (corner of Hwy 61 & the entrance to the country club).

Customer input is an important part of the Commission's analysis of the requested increase and is a factor in determining whether a hearing will be conducted. Customers are encouraged to call to the Commission's attention any questions or concerns related to the Company's Application, including service, billing procedures or other factors important in determining the reasonableness of charges. Customers may have a right to intervene in this matter. Customers wishing to communicate with the Commission, or to request information on intervention in the proceeding, should contact the Commission's Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 (if located outside the Phoenix local calling area) or 602-542-4251 in the Phoenix local calling area. Customers may also contact the Tucson Commission office by calling 800-535-0148 (if located outside the Tucson local calling area) or 520-628-6555 in the Tucson local calling area.

Customers are advised that the Commission may act upon the Application without a hearing. Regardless of whether a formal hearing is held, comments submitted in writing will be placed in the office file, which the Commission reviews prior to making the final Decision on the Application.
