PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 11, 2007, Pine Water Company ("PWC" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application seeking approval to (1) encumber a part of its plant and system pursuant to A.R.S. §40-285(A); and (2) issue evidence of indebtedness pursuant to A.R.S. §40-302(A).

A Procedural Order was issued September 14, 2007, scheduling a hearing for October 15, 2007, and directing the Company to mail and publish notice of the hearing.

On September 18, 2007, Pine Water filed a Request to Change Schedule due to unavailability of the Company's counsel on the scheduled hearing date. The Company requested that the hearing be rescheduled to commence on October 26, 2007, and that corresponding changes to the procedural schedule set forth in the prior Procedural Order be made.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing in this matter shall be rescheduled for **October 26, 2007, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the offices of the Commission, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the deadline for publication and mailing of the notice shall be changed to **October 9, 2007**; and the deadlines for requesting intervention and for filing objections to the Staff Report shall be changed to **October 19, 2007**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects, the September 14, 2007, Procedural Order shall remain in full force and effect.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
2 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rule 33 (c) and (d) of the
4 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court with respect to practice of law and admission pro hac vice.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
6 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
7 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation
8 to appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the
9 matter is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to
10 withdraw by the Administrative Law Judge.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
12 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
13 hearing.


