REQUEST FOR PROCEDURAL ORDER

On September 14, 2007, the administrative law judge ("ALJ") granted Staff's request to continue the hearing in this matter until January 16, 2008. The ALJ thereafter asked the parties to propose a schedule to govern additional procedural matters by September 21, 2007. Counsel for Staff consulted with counsel for Sempra Energy Solutions to determine a mutually convenient schedule. Thereafter, Staff forwarded the following proposal to the remaining parties:

- 1) December 14, 2007 as the due date for Staff testimony and any other rebuttal (as to previously filed testimony) that any party might wish to file;
- 2) January 7, 2008 as the due date for responses to Staff testimony;
- 3) January 9, 2008 as the due date for objections to prefiled testimony and for the procedural conference; and
- 4) January 11, 2008 as the cut-off date for serving new discovery.


Counsel for Staff has been informed that these dates are acceptable to the following parties: Sempra Energy Solutions, New West Energy, Tucson Electric Power Company, UNS Electric, Air Liquide, Arizona Public Service Company, the Residential Utility Consumer Office, and the Arizona Investment Council. Intervenor SRP has elected not to comment upon the proposed schedule in light of its intention to withdraw its intervention.

In summary, it is Staff's understanding that all parties have accepted the above proposed schedule, except for SRP, which has elected not to comment due to its intention to withdraw.
