PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On July 30, 2007, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 69722. Decision No. 69722 remanded this case to the Hearing Division for further proceedings regarding whether Arizona Water Company should continue to hold a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") at this time for the area depicted in Exhibit B to that Decision (the Cornman extension area).

On August 17, 2007, Cornman Tweedy 560, LLC ("Cornman") filed an Application for Rehearing and Reconsideration of Decision No. 69722. The Commission took no action thereon.

By Procedural Order issued September 21, 1007, a Procedural Conference was set for October 3, 2007, to allow the parties to Decision No. 69722 an opportunity to discuss procedural matters related to the ordered remand proceeding, including a suitable hearing date and an associated procedural schedule.

On October 3, 2007, counsel for the parties contacted the Hearing Division and requested that the Procedural Conference be reset due to unavailability of witnesses for Arizona Water Company.

The parties' request is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **Procedural Conference** currently set to be held in this matter on October 5, 2007, is hereby reset to commence on **October 16, 2007, at 1:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street,

1 Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
3 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the  
4 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
6 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
