The purpose of this Notice is to update you regarding some new and exciting changes in the Docket Control Center at the Arizona Corporation Commission.

First, a new docket number system has been implemented for two reasons: 1) the installation of new computers and a new database and 2) the large increase in the number and complexity of cases filed.

The goal of the new system is two-fold: 1) to prepare the Docket Control Center for database upgrades and scanning capabilities targeted for the year 2000 and 2) to better serve the public by maintaining accurate records and providing quality customer service.

A letter has been mailed to all companies informing them of the new docket number(s) and information, as it appears in the database. The following changes have been made in the docket number system:

- 1) The first letter in the docket number represents the type of utility service provided (G=Gas, W=Water, E=Electric, T=Telecommunications, S=Securities, RR=Railroad etc.) See enclosed sheet for all utility type codes.
- 2) The docket number will not change, but a leading zero is added to prepare for future growth. (Example: W-01234)
- 3) The division indicator follows the 5-digit docket number. For most companies an "A" will follow the docket number, other companies will have additional alpha-indicators in order to identify multiple divisions or multiple records on file. (Example: W-01234A)
- 4) The matter year will continue to identify the filing year. (Example: W-01234A-98)
- 5) The matter number will include a leading zero in order to prepare for future growth. (Example: W-01234A-98-0123)

In the letter, companies were asked to review their new docket number(s) and corresponding business information. The companies were also asked to contact Connie Northrop,

Examiner Technician II, at 602-542-3477 to correct information, if necessary. If you represent companies or manage document filings for companies, you may obtain a list of current cases with their corresponding new docket numbers by contacting the Docket Control Center at 602-542-3477.


Please distribute the new docket number(s) to all personnel in your office or firm who may work on securities or utilities cases, which will be filed, at the Arizona Corporation Commission. **Docket Control requests that all companies and members of the public begin using the new docket numbers immediately.** However, a brief transition period will be allowed so that necessary adjustments to databases and records may be made.

The second major change is the requirement of a Docket Cover Sheet. The Docket Cover Sheet must accompany all documents filed in the Docket Control Center. Please see Cover Sheet enclosed. **Required use of the Docket Cover Sheet will be effective February 2, 1998.** We ask your cooperation by completing the Cover Sheet, in detail, specifying the exact type of case or document being filed. Always reference docket numbers and decision numbers, where indicated on the Cover Sheet. The purpose of the Cover Sheet is to ensure accuracy and efficiency in processing your clients' documents. Failure to use the Docket Cover Sheet may result in the delay of processing your clients' filing or refusal to accept documents. You may duplicate the enclosed Cover Sheet or obtain copies in the Docket Control Center. If you have any questions regarding the Docket Cover Sheet, please call the Docket Control Center at 602-542-3477.

The Docket Control Center's business hours will remain 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (except Open Meeting Weeks) until further notice. Prior to 9:00 a.m. documents may be delivered to the second floor Utilities Division. I apologize for any inconvenience; however, the change in the business hours is necessary for the continuation of quality control and data validation due to the database conversion.

I appreciate your continued cooperation and assistance. On behalf of the staff at the Arizona Corporation Commission, I wish you a Happy New Year.
