PROCEDURAL ORDER

10 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

11 On June 14, 2006, Beaver Dam Water Company, Inc. ("Beaver Dam" or "Company") filed  
12 with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of  
13 Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide wastewater service in Mohave County, Arizona.

14 On July 14, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed an Insufficiency Letter  
15 in this matter.

16 On August 21, 2006, Beaver Dam filed its Affidavit of Publication and an Amended Legal  
17 Description.

18 On September 15, 2006, Staff filed its second Insufficiency Letter.

19 On January 8, 2007, Beaver Dam filed its response to Staff's second Insufficiency Letter.

20 On April 25, 2007, Beaver Dam filed an amended Sewer Tariff Schedule and an Amended  
21 Legal Description.

22 On May 23, 2007, Staff filed its third Insufficiency Letter.

23 On June 25, 2007, Beaver Dam filed its response to Staff's third Insufficiency Letter.

24 On July 10, 2007, Staff filed a Sufficiency Letter in this docket indicating that the Beaver  
25 Dam has met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C").

26 On August 3, 2007, a Procedural Order was issued setting the hearing and other procedural  
27 deadlines in this matter.

1 On August 30, 2007, Staff filed a Motion to Extend Time to file its Staff Report from August  
2 31, 2007 to September 7, 2007.

3 Our August 30, 2007, by Procedural Order Staff's Motion to Extend Time was granted.

4 On October 3, 2007, a hearing was held in this matter. At the conclusion of the hearing Staff  
5 was directed to file a late-filed exhibit in this matter.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff's late-filed exhibit shall include a **review the**  
7 **Proforma Income Statements submitted by Beaver Dam at hearing and Staff shall file on or**  
8 **before October 15, 2007, its exhibit with its comments and recommendations in light of the**  
9 **Commission policy Staff articulated at hearing.**


10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Beaver Dam shall **file any response to Staff's**  
11 **recommendations regarding the Proforma Income Statements on or before October 25, 2007.**

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock in this matter is extended accordingly.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized  
14 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the  
15 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,  
17 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
18 hearing.
