Dear Ms. Genung:

Enclosed for your convenience is a copy of a filing transmitted under separate cover to Docket Control of the Commission. The enclosed pages are a supplement to Triplet Mountain Communications, Inc's ("Triplet") proposed tariff. The supplement sets out terms, conditions and proposed maximum rates for Triplet's toll service offering.

As indicated earlier to the Commission, Triplet has applied to the Commission for authority to provide resold long distance telecommunications services in Arizona. Triplet is currently in the process of selecting its underlying provider. After selection, Triplet will negotiate a contract that will include the rates charged by the underlying provider. At that time, Triplet will update its tariff to include its actual rates for toll services.

Triplet has calculated its proposed maximum rates by analyzing market conditions, the costs of serving the geographic area and the maximum rates of other existing providers. These providers included: CenturyTel Long Distance, LLC, Connect!LD, Inc., Qwest LD Corporation, Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. d/b/a Working Assets Long Distance, and XO Long Distance Services, Inc. The relevant pages from the providers' tariffs are attached as Attachment A.

Triplet believes that its proposed maximum rate of \$0.30 per minute is just and reasonable based on a competitive market analysis. The maximum rates for intrastate toll service for each of the providers listed above are set out below. Triplet's proposed maximum rate per minute is no higher than its future main competitor, Qwest LD Corporation.

**3.7 Matchmaker**

CenturyTel Matchmaker is a basic switched toll service for residential users billing less than \$10.00 per month. Calls are rated based upon time of day, day of week, distance of call and call duration and are billed in arrears. This service is only offered as an addition to Matchmaker interstate service. All calls are billed in one (1) minute increments after an initial period, for billing purposes, of one (1) minute.
