19. TOLL SERVICES19.1 General Description

Toll Services provides direct dialed communications services which are available for use on a twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven days a week basis. End users may originate such services from locations served by the Company and may terminate such calls to any location within the United States.

For the purposes of this Section 19.1, timing of messages will be determined by the following method.

(a) Chargeable time begins when connection is established between the calling station and the called station.

(b) Chargeable time ends when the calling station releases the network connection (or "hangs up"). If the called station "hangs up" but the calling station does not, chargeable time ends when the network connection is released by automatic timing equipment in the telephone network.

19.2 Obligations of the End User

The obligations of the end user are as set forth in 2.3 preceding.

19.3 Payment Arrangements and Credit Allowances

The payment arrangements and credit allowances as set forth in Section 2.5 preceding apply.

19.4 Rate Regulations

Toll Services charges will apply for each intrastate, interstate, and/or international toll call made at the rates set forth in Section 20.19 following. Usage rates are billed in six (6) second increments with an initial billing period of six seconds. The duration of each call for bill purposes will be rounded off to the nearest highest increment. Fractional cents will be rounded to the nearest cent using natural rounding, however, there will be a minimum charge of \$0.01 per completed call.

19.5 Miscellaneous Rates and Charges

The Company may adjust its rates and charges or imposes additional rates and charges on its Customers in order to recover amounts it is required by governmental or quasi-governmental authorities to collect from or pay to others in support of statutory or regulatory programs. Examples of such programs include, but are not limited to, the Universal Service Fund, and compensation to payphone service providers for the use of their payphones to access Company services.

19. TOLL SERVICES (CONT'D)19.6 Contracts

At the option of the Company, service may be offered on a contract basis to meet specialized requirements of the Customer not contemplated in this tariff. The terms of each contract shall be mutually agreed upon between the Customer and Company and may include discounts off of rates contained herein, waiver of recurring or nonrecurring charges, charges for specially designed and constructed services not contained in the Company's general service offerings, or other customized features. The terms of the contract may be based partially or completely on the term and volume commitment, type of originating or terminating access, mixture of services or other distinguishing features. Service shall be available to all similarly situated Customers for a fixed period of time following the initial offering to the first contract Customer as specific in each individual contract.

19.7 Promotions

From time to time the Company shall, at its option, promote subscription or stimulate network usage by offering to waive some or all of the nonrecurring or recurring charges for the Customer (if eligible) of target services for a limited duration. Such promotions shall be made available to all similarly situated Customers in the target market area.
