PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 15, 2006, UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNSE" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") the above-captioned application requesting an increase in rates and approval of financing.

The hearing on the application commenced as scheduled, and concluded on October 2, 2007.

On October 11, 2007, October 16, 2007, and October 17, 2007, the Company, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff"), and the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") filed their final schedules in this proceeding.

On October 26, 2007, Staff's Unopposed Motion for an Extension of Time to File Briefs was filed in this docket. Therein, Staff requested that the deadline for filing initial briefs be extended to November 5, 2007, and that the deadline for filing reply briefs be extended to November 19, 2007. Staff stated that it had conferred with the Company, RUCO and Mr. Magruder, and that all three parties are in agreement with Staff's requested revised briefing schedule.

Staff's request is reasonable, as long as the timeclock in this matter is extended accordingly.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the deadlines for filing initial and reply briefs in this
2 proceeding are extended from October 30, 2007, and November 13, 2007, to November 5, 2007, and
3 November 19, 2007.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties' briefs shall clearly state and reference
5 appropriate and correct dollar figures; that the parties' initial briefs shall cite to and address the final
6 positions of the parties as set forth in the final schedules; and that the parties' reply briefs shall cite to
7 and address the parties' arguments and positions as set forth in the initial briefs and final schedules.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock in this matter is extended accordingly.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
10 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
11 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
13 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
