AMENDED PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 23, 2007, North Mohave Valley Corporation ("NMVC") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide water service in Mohave County, Arizona.

On August 22, 2007, Staff filed a Letter of Insufficiency in this docket indicating that NMVC has not met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C").

On August 27, 2007, NMVC filed an amended legal description and on August 30, 2007, NMVC filed Proof of Publication.

On September 19, 2007, NMVC filed its Response to Staff's Insufficiency Letter.

On October 16, 2007, Staff filed a Sufficiency Letter in this docket, indicating NMVC's application had met the requirements of the A.A.C.

On October 30, 2007, by Procedural order, a hearing in this matter was scheduled for December 13, 2007, and other procedural deadlines were set.

On November 1, 2007, Staff filed a Motion to extend the deadline for filing its Staff Report from October 30, 2007, to December 17, 2007. Staff requested the additional time to ensure that the Staff Report would provide the Commission with the information and analysis it would need in order to evaluate the issues raised in this proceeding.

1 On November 16, 2007, by Procedural Order, Staff's Motion to extend the deadline for filing
2 its Staff Report was granted.

3 On November 30, 2007, NMVC informed the Hearing Division that Notice of the December
4 13, 2007 hearing date had been mailed to the property owners in the proposed extension area and
5 published in a newspaper of general circulation.

6 Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-101, the Commission now issues this Amended Procedural Order
7 to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing in this matter originally set for December**
9 **13, 2007 at 10:00 a.m., is hereby reset to commence on January 31, 2008, at 10:00 a.m.,** or as
10 soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Arizona
11 85007.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **the December 13, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. hearing date and**
13 **time shall be reserved for taking public comment and the evidentiary portion of the hearing**
14 **will commence on January 31, 2008 at 10:00 a.m.**

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **intervention** shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-
16 105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **December 31, 2007.**

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **objections to any motions to intervene** must be filed no
18 later than **January 11, 2008.**

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that NMVC shall **file certification of mailing and publication**
20 as soon as practicable after the mailing/publication has been completed, but not later than **January**
21 **11, 2008.**

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice shall be deemed complete upon mailing and
23 publication of same, notwithstanding the failure of an individual property owner to read or receive
24 the notice.

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall file a **Staff Report** on or before **December 17,**
26 **2007.**

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **objections to the Staff Report** shall be filed on or
2 before **December 31, 2007**.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock in this matter is extended accordingly.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
5 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding as the matter is set for public hearing.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rule 31 and 38 of the Rules of
7 the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*
8 *hac vice*.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
10 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
11 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to
12 appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter
13 is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by
14 the Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
16 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
17 hearing.
