FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent OCMC, Inc. ("OCMC" or "Company") is a public service corporation as defined by Article XV of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. § 40-282.
2. On December 3, 2004, in Decision No. 67444, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") granted OCMC's application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold interexchange services and alternative operator services in the State of Arizona.
3. On May 30, 2007, Staff attempted to contact the Company regarding the filing of its 2006 Annual Report and outstanding compliance items. It was noted that the phone number and address on file with the Commission were no longer correct.
4. After subsequent research, it was discovered that on May 12, 2006, Meridian Financial Advisors, Ltd., dba The Meridian Group was appointed as the Receiver over the assets,

1 property and business of OCMC pursuant to an order entered by the United States District Court
2 for the Southern District of Indiana. The Receiver worked to transition the customers to other
3 carriers and to cancel all agreements of the Company.

4 5. On October 15, 2007, Staff received a copy of the Court Order and official notice
5 from the Receiver indicating that OCMC has ceased all operations.

6 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7 1. OCMC is an Arizona public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV,
8 Section 2, of the Arizona Constitution.

9 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over OCMC and over the subject matter of the
10 application.

11 3. The Commission, having reviewed the application concludes that it is in the public
12 interest to rescind Decision No. 67444 and to cancel the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity
13 of OCMC, Inc.

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ORDER



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall become effective immediately.




