10 Livco Water Company, Inc. ("Livco" or the "Company"), by and through undersigned  
counsel, respectfully states the following in support of this Application:

11 1. Livco is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of  
12 Arizona. Its principal place of business is #1 County Road, Concho, Arizona, 85924.

13 2. Livco is a public service corporation primarily engaged in the business of providing  
14 water utility service in its certificated area within portions of Apache County, Arizona.

15 3. The Company herein seeks Commission approval to enter into certain loan  
16 agreements necessary to fund a Water Meter Replacement Program that includes replacing all of  
17 the Company's approximately 300 meters of varying sizes, which are old and unreliable.  
18 Attached hereto as **Attachment One**, and included herein for all purposes by this reference, is a  
19 Summary of the number, size, and price of the meters , as installed, adjusted for the anticipated  
20 2008 acquisition/installation date. Also appended to that Attachment is supplier's estimate of  
21 the meter prices.

1           4. Livco seeks Commission approval for authority to issue long term promissory notes  
2 or bonds and other evidence from the Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona  
3 (“WIFA”) for the purpose of repaying the above referenced Water Meter Replacement Program.  
4 The Company expects the documentation for the loan will be substantially similar to the  
5 documents WIFA has required for other similar loans. The interest rate is expected to be  
6 approximately and have a twenty 20 year amortization. The exact interest rate and term will be  
7 determined at the time the Company executes those documents.

8           5. Attached hereto as **Attachment Two** and incorporated herein by reference for all  
9 purposes, are Livco’s Financial Statements as of December 31, 2006.

10           6. Attached hereto as **Attachment Three**, and incorporated herein by this reference for all  
11 purposes, is a Proforma Capital Structure before and after the requested financing.

12           7. Attached as **Attachment Four** and incorporated herein for all purposes is the  
13 Resolution of the Livco’s Board of Directors authorizing this Application and the issuance of the  
14 requested loan.

15           8. Livco will provide notice of the filing of this Application in conformity with A.R.S.  
16 §40-302 in the form attached as **Attachment Five** and incorporated herein by this reference, which  
17 exhibit contains the form of the Public Notice to be filed with the Commission, or in such other  
18 form as ordered by the Commission.

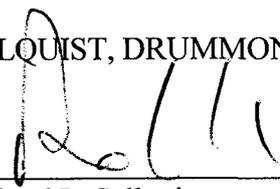
19           9. In Livco’s opinion the purpose to which proceeds of the issuance of the promissory  
20 notes or bonds and other evidence of indebtedness will be applied as set forth above are lawful,  
21 and within its powers and are compatible with the public interest, with sound financial practices,  
22 and with the proper performance of the Company of service as a public service corporation and  
23 will not impair its ability to perform that service. The Company is further of the opinion that the

1 issuance of the issuance of the promissory notes or bonds and other evidence of indebtedness as  
2 herein contemplated is reasonably necessary or appropriate for the aforementioned purposes.

3 WHEREFORE, Livco requests that the Commission make such inquiry or investigation  
4 that the Commission may deem necessary and appropriate; make the findings required by A.R.S.  
5 §40-301 and §40-302 relative to the purposes of issuing the promissory notes or bonds and other  
6 evidence of indebtedness as herein stated; and thereafter issue an immediately effective order(s) (i)  
7 setting the matter for an evidentiary hearing only if deemed necessary, (ii) authorizing the  
8 Company to issue promissory notes or bonds and other evidence of indebtedness, in the same  
9 manner and for the purposes herein contemplated, (iii) stating that the issuance of the promissory  
10 notes or bonds and other evidence of indebtedness, is reasonably necessary or appropriate for the  
11 purposes set forth above, and (iv) stating that such purposes are within those permitted by A.R.S.  
12 §40-301.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

**December 12, 2007**

The President reported on the need to institute a Water Meter Replacement Program, and the long-term financing of those facilities, and the need for an Arizona Corporation Commission (the "Commission") Order authorizing the financing of that plant. Discussion of those matters ensued.

Thereafter, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, it was:

RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes the officers of the Corporation to file an Application with the Water Infrastructure Finance Authority of Arizona (WIFA) for a loan not to exceed \$124,000 at terms favorable to the Corporation for the purpose of funding a Water Meter Replacement Program and appurtenant facilities as described in Exhibit A hereto, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes the officers of the Corporation to file an application with the Commission for authority to issue Promissory Note(s) and evidence of indebtedness necessary to fund the Water Meter Replacement Program, and the filing of any and all amendments and supplements to said application, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receiving the requisite authority from WIFA and the Commission, and subject to other legal requirements, the Corporation shall issue Promissory Note(s) and such evidence of the long-term indebtedness for up to \$124,000 under terms and conditions advantageous to the Corporation for the purpose of funding certain plant and equipment additions, as hereinabove described, all in the manner and in the terms and conditions provided in the above-mentioned resolutions, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proper officers of the Corporation be and each of them hereby is, authorized, in the name and on behalf of the Corporation, to conduct any and all negotiations, to make any and all arrangements, do and perform any and all acts and things and to execute and deliver any and all officer's certificates and other documents and instruments as they deem necessary or appropriate in order to consummate the issuance and otherwise to effectuate the purposes of each and all of the foregoing resolutions.
