
CERTIFICATE OF NOTICE



PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE HEARING ON THE APPLICATION OF ARIZONA WATER COMPANY FOR AN EXTENSION OF ITS CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE WATER SERVICES IN PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA (DOCKET NO. W-01445A-07-0291)

On May 14, 2007, Arizona Water Company ("AWC" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension to its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide water services in Pinal County, Arizona. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has not yet made a recommendation regarding AWC's application, and the Commission is not bound by the proposals made by AWC, Staff, or any intervenors. The Commission will issue a decision regarding AWC's application following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. Copies of the application are available at AWC's offices 220 East 2nd Street, Casa Grande, Arizona 85222, and the Commission's offices at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona, for public inspection during regular business hours and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning January 17, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via email (visit http://www.azcc.gov/utility/cons/index.htm for instructions), or by mailing a letter referencing Docket Number W-01445A-07-0291, et al. to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you

would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, and you must send copies of the motion to the Company or its counsel, and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number, and the name, address, and telephone number of any party upon whom documents are to be served in your place, if desired;

2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.); and

3. A statement certifying that a copy of your motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before January 4, 2008. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf.
