



EXHIBIT A

On February 21, 2007 Broadweave Networks of Arizona ("BNA" or "Applicant") submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate" or "CC&N") to provide resold long distance, resold local exchange and facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Arizona. The Applicant also requested that its services be classified as competitive. The Commission's Utilities Division Staff has not yet made a recommendation regarding BNA's application, and the Commission is not bound by the proposals made by BNA, Staff, or any intervenors, and the Applicant will be required to provide this service under the rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission. Copies of the Application will be available at the Applicant's offices at 10813 South River Front Parkway, Suite 500, South Jordan, Utah 84095, and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning January 23, 2008, at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comment will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via e-mail at <http://www.azcc.gov/utility/cons/index.htm> for instructions), or by mailing a letter referencing Docket Number T-20514A-07-0113 to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007. The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, and you must send such copies of the motion to the Applicant or its counsel, and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number, and the name, address, and telephone number of any party upon whom documents are to be served in your place, if desired;
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicant, a shareholder of the Applicant, etc.); and
3. A statement certifying that a copy of your motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before January 4, 2008. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf.




