PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 28, 2007, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 69887, a Complaint and Order to Show Cause ("Complaint" or "OSC") in Docket No. C-00000A-07-0430 against a number of Respondents for failing to file their 2005 Utilities Division Annual Reports ("Annual Reports").

On September 26, 2007, a Respondent in that proceeding, Global Internetworking, Inc. ("Global") filed, in response to the Commission's OSC, an application to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") in this docket which was assigned Docket No. T-04105A-07-0548. The application stated that Global no longer intends to operate in the State of Arizona.

On November 26, 2007, by Procedural Order in Docket No. C-00000A-07-0430, the above-captioned docket was ordered to be administratively closed.

On December 4, 2007, by Procedural Order, the above-captioned proceeding was ordered administratively closed.

On December 19, 2007, the Procedural Order issued on November 26, 2007, in docket No. C-00000A-07-0430 was amended and Global was dismissed from the proceeding due to its having filed the application herein to cancel its Certificate.

Accordingly, this docket should be reopened.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this docket shall be reopened and the application proceed on its merits.
