MOTION TO SUSPEND TARIFF

On June 6, 2007, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") granted Spanish Trail Water Company ("STWC") and Saguaro Water Company ("Saguaro") conditional approval of their joint application to transfer a portion of Saguaro's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to STWC. The companies were ordered to file a Hook-Up Fee Tariff application within 90 days of the conditional approval.

On July 17, 2007, the companies filed a motion requesting an extension of time in preparing the tariff. Specifically, the companies expressed difficulties in developing estimates regarding the amount and the pace of future growth within the territories. The requested extension was granted and the tariff deadline was extended to December 6, 2007.

On December 6, 2007, the companies docketed the tariff. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-367(A) utilities are required to provide 30 days notice to the ACC during which Staff can evaluate the potential effect on revenues of all pending changes. The notice period in this matter will have passed on January 6, 2008. After that time, the utility could begin to charge the rates proposed therein, absent ACC objection. Staff hereby provides such objection.

ACC Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") has received and begun analysis of the tariff. However, Staff has encountered difficulties in analyzing the tariff's potential revenue effects which are similar to those previously encountered by the company which prompted the companies' request for an additional 90 days in which to comply.

1 Staff has not completed its analysis at this time and can not do so by January 6, 2008. Staff
2 believes it will need approximately 90 days to fully examine the tariff and its effects.

3 WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests that the imposition of the tariff be suspended until
4 Staff has analyzed its potential effects.
