On July 2, 2007, Diablo Village Water Company ("Diablo Village" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission for an overall revenue increase of \$47,601, which is an increase of approximately 9.63 percent. Under the Company's proposal, the typical residential customer on a 5/8" x 3/4" meter, using an average of 5,952 gallons per month, would experience a monthly increase of \$1.99, or 5.27 percent. The typical residential customer on a 1" meter, using an average of 7,359 gallons per month, would experience a monthly increase of \$5.61 per month, or 7.78 percent.

The Commission's Utilities Division Staff has not yet made a recommendation regarding the Company's rate increase proposal, and the Commission will determine the appropriate rate relief to be granted based on the evidence of record in this proceeding. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Company, Staff, or any intervenors and, therefore, the final rates approved in this docket may be lower or higher than the rates described above.
