Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1107, SBC Long Distance, LLC (d/b/a AT&T Long Distance and SBC Long Distance) ("SBC LD") files this Application to discontinue the provision of local exchange business service in Arizona on March 31, 2008. This is the final phase of a discontinuance of business and residential local exchange voice service. As authorized by Commission Decision Nos. 69885 and 69886 dated August 28, 2007, SBC LD discontinued last year the provision of local exchange service to residential customers in Arizona and the provision of local exchange service for business customers in the Tucson area.

By this Application, SBC LD seeks Commission approval to discontinue competitive local exchange voice service to its few business customers in the state. Currently, SBC LD has only about 67 remaining business customers—most of which are located in the Phoenix metropolitan area—which will be affected by this request.

All affected customers were notified last month of the proposed service discontinuance. All customers will have access to multiple alternative providers. SBC LD will continue to use its

1 local exchange authority to provide tariffed business data services and also will continue to offer
2 intrastate and interstate long distance services to Arizona customers.

3 In support of its Application, SBC LD states as follows:

4 1. SBC LD is a competitive local exchange carrier ("CLEC"). It is authorized to
5 provide business local exchange service throughout the State of Arizona, excluding the Tucson
6 metropolitan area.¹ The 67 customers affected by this request were originally customers of SBC
7 Telecom, Inc. SBC Telecom, Inc. and SBC Long Distance reorganized in 2005 and the
8 surviving entity is SBC LD.²

9 2. SBC LD provides local exchange services to its remaining business customers in
10 Arizona through resale and by using UNE loops acquired from Qwest, as well as facilities owned
11 by SBC LD. Given the fact that only 67 customers are currently taking service, it is no longer
12 economically feasible for SBC LD to continue to incur these costs to serve so few customers.

13 3. By sending out customer notifications and filing this application now, affected
14 customers will have more than sufficient time to locate another service provider. Also, they will
15 have time to transfer or port their local telephone numbers to the new service provider.

16 4. In accordance with A.A.C. R14-2-1107.A, SBC LD provides the following
17 information as required by the regulation:

1 **(a) Reasons for the proposed discontinuance of service or**
2 **abandonment of service area.** As described above, SBC LD has elected to stop
3 providing business service in Arizona because it is not cost effective for it to
4 continue to do so.

5 **(b) Verification that all affected customers have been notified of the**
6 **proposed discontinuance or abandonment, and that all affected customers will**
7 **have access to an alternative local exchange service provider.** Attached as
8 Exhibit A is the affidavit of Sam G. Maropis, Area Manager-Regulatory Operations
9 for AT&T Services, Inc., verifying that notification by letter was sent to each
10 affected customer and that all affected customers will have access to alternative
11 providers. A sample copy of the letter sent to all customers last month is attached to
12 the affidavit.

13 **(c) A plan for the refund of deposits collected pursuant to R14-2-503,**
14 **subsection B.** SBC LD is not holding deposits for any of the business customers
15 affected by the request. Therefore, no plan for return of deposits is necessary.

16 **(d) List of all alternative utilities providing the same or similar**
17 **service within the affected geographic area.** The customers impacted by this
18 application are located primarily in the Phoenix metropolitan area. Attached as
19 Exhibit B is a list of authorized Incumbent and Competitive Local Exchange
20 Carriers taken from the Commission's website which includes carriers providing the
21 same service in these areas. In addition to these service providers, there are wireless
22 carriers and Voice over Internet Protocol service providers providing substitute
23 services in this area as well.

24 5. In accordance with A.A.C. R14-2-1107.B, SBC LD will publish legal notice of
this Application in all counties affected by the Application within twenty (20) days of filing this
Application. A copy of the notice is attached as Exhibit C. SBC LD will file proof of
publication with the Commission once publication is completed.

WHEREFORE, SBC LD requests that the Commission approve its Application to
discontinue the provision of business local exchange voice service in Arizona effective
March 28, 2008.





I, Sam G. Maropis, being duly sworn, state that I am an Area Manager-Regulatory Operations for AT&T Services, Inc. I have responsibility for oversight and managing various regulatory activities of SBC Long Distance, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Long Distance ("SBC Long Distance"), I hereby affirm the following:

- (1) SBC Long Distance provides local exchange service to approximately 67 local exchange business customers in the State of Arizona.
- (2) The attached letter (Exhibit 1) advising customers that, subject to Arizona Corporation Commission review, SBC Long Distance shall no longer provide local exchange service to business customers in the State of Arizona effective March 28, 2008, was sent by SBC Long Distance to all impacted Arizona business customers receiving local service in the State on December 4, 2007.
- (3) The business customers provided local exchange service by SBC Long Distance are provided service, in part, obtained from Unbundled Network

Elements ("UNEs") obtained from the incumbent local exchange carrier ("ILEC"). Therefore, all impacted customers will be able to obtain local exchange service from an alternative provider, the ILEC. Further, AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc., an affiliate of SBC Long Distance and a competitive local exchange carrier ("CLEC") that provides service in the State of Arizona, will be able to provide local exchange service to the impacted customers as well. In addition, these customers likely may have access to other CLECs and multiple wireless providers.



Important Notice Regarding Discontinuance of Local Telephone Service

Dear Valued SBC Business Customer:

AT&T values your business, and we'd like to update you on some important changes underway. As you may know, in November 2005, AT&T Corp. and SBC Communications Inc. joined together to form the new AT&T. As part of the integration process, the affiliated companies are streamlining their business service portfolios. As a result, several local telephone service offerings by SBC in Arizona are being phased out.

Therefore, this letter is to provide you 90 day notice that your service is among some local telephone service offerings by AT&T Long Distance (formerly SBC Long Distance) that are being phased out in Arizona. It is our intention, subject to regulatory approval, to discontinue these services starting on March 31, 2008.

SBC Long Distance will no longer provide the following products:

- Business Access Lines including all packages and bundles such as: Phone Solutions and Phone Solutions Plus
- Primary Rate ISDN (PRI)
- Digital Trunks (DTS)
- T-1 Integrated Access (IAS)

Only the services list above are impacted by this letter; other AT&T services such as long distance calling and transport, private line, frame and ATM services or local services from another affiliate, will not be affected by this action.

At this time, SBC Long Distance, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Long Distance ("SBC") provides you with local telephone service, using one of the above products. Accordingly, subject to the Commission's approval, as of March 31, 2008, SBC will no longer provide your local telephone service. **You must take immediate action.**

AT&T still offers alternative local services to those being phased out. We sincerely hope you will remain with AT&T. For questions about how you can take advantage of AT&T's new suite of products and services, we invite you to contact your account representative.

Please disregard this letter if you have already placed an order to transfer your local phone service to another service provider, or if you plan to move your service to AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. ("AT&T") prior to March 31, 2008.

Please do not send inquiries or payments to the return address on this notice. If you have comments or questions, please contact AT&T Customer Service at the toll-free number on your bill.

We sincerely hope you will remain with AT&T. However, you also have the right to select another local telephone service provider, and can discontinue your current service without penalty. If you select another provider, that carrier will be able to provide you with a list of their services and charges. You may also look in the front of your Yellow Pages directory under "telephone companies," or in the front of your White Pages directory for a list of local telephone service providers. Once you find the provider of your choice, you should call that provider to order your new service.

If you have not yet made arrangements to move your service to AT&T or to transfer your business local phone service to an alternate service provider, you must do so on or before February 1st, 2008 to prevent the loss of your local business telephone service. If you act by this date, there will be sufficient time to start your new service before your current service ends. If you do not act by this date, you could lose your local phone service on March 31, 2008. Also, you will need to work with your local service provider to select a long distance service provider and to assure that you can keep your telephone number(s). Note that an alternate provider may refuse service to a customer if that customer owes an outstanding balance for jurisdictional services.

If you do not select another local service provider promptly, your local telephone service will be disconnected, you will be without dial tone, and you may lose your ability to retain your existing telephone number(s).

After you switch to another local telephone service provider and SBC discontinues your service, you will receive a final bill within 7 to 14 days. If we owe you a refund, we will send it to you within 30 to 45 days. Please be aware that you are responsible for paying all bills from SBC.
