



Dear Chairman Gleason and Arizona Commissioners,

Received late December, 2007 is a copy of a December 20, 2007 letter to the ACC by Mr. Michael R. Peevey, President of the California Public Utility Commission, with an enclosure of a copy of his December 13, 2007 letter to ACC Chairman Mike Gleason, both regarding ACC Case No. 130 that was decided May 31, 2007.

With respect to the case hearing before the APP&TLSC, and then before the Arizona Commissioners, this case intervenor is extremely disappointed by these after-the-fact actions of the CPUC President.

Interventions in Case 130 were filed timely before the APP&TLSC hearing began June 26, 2007. In reviewing the transcripts of this Case, either at the beginning or on any subsequent day of the hearing, Mr. Peevey neither made his presence known to Chairman Woodall of the APP&TLSC nor made a request to the Chairman to be an intervenor in "130".

In essence Mr. Peevey's December 2007 collective letters are requesting that he now be an intervenor in Case No. 130 and that the ACC reopen the Case. I totally oppose "130" be reopened, and totally oppose Mr. Peevey being an "130 intervenor".

Respectively, I recommend the ACC Commissioners ignore any formal or informal intervention request by Mr. Peevey. Case No. 130 was decided according to Arizona Law, and that decision remains permanent on behalf of Arizona Electric Ratepayers.
