



Insufficiency Letter

Dear Mr. Palmer:

The application of Ashcreek Water Company for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CC&N”) has not met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”). Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-411(C)(3), to correct the deficiencies, please provide the following information:

1. Please explain the relationship of Desert Rose Water Company to Ashcreek Water Company.
2. Please explain where in the proposed CC&N expansion territory the additional customers are located.
3. Is any of the territory included in the CC&N expansion on state or federal land, and if so, has Ashcreek received a letter from applicable entities indicating they do not oppose inclusion in the CC&N expansion?
4. Based on the submitted Application (Attachment “D”), the Company is providing water service to 99 customers. Please provide the following information:
 - a. Number of customers located within the Company’s existing CC&N.
 - b. Number of customers located within the requested area.
 - c. Number of customers in the White Fence Farms Subdivision.
5. Please state if the submitted Water Use Data is from November 2006 to November 2007.

6. Please state if the requested area includes a subdivision.
7. Please submit a current compliance status report from the ADEQ for Ashcreek water system.
8. What is the status of the ADEQ Approval to Construct and Approval of Construction for the storage tank required by the Commission Decision No. 69581?

Pursuant to A.A.C R14-2-411(C)(3), Staff may terminate an application if the applicant does not remedy all deficiencies within 60 calendar days of the notice of deficiency.
