Page 5, between lines 23 and 24 INSERT:

Resolution

25. APS' E-56 Schedule includes Excess Demand charges¹, which the Customer must pay if the Customer's demand exceeds the Total Contract Demand. As proposed by Staff, however, the SC-S Commercial Electric Supply/Purchase Agreement² does not include a comparable monetary penalty for exceeding the maximum electric service demand specified in the Agreement. Instead, the proposed SC-C Agreement provides that the Customer is liable only for any physical damage resulting from unauthorized excess demand.³

26. We will adopt Staff's recommendations in this matter except that we will direct that the Agreement be modified to include Excess Demand charges to be paid by the Customer if the maximum electric service demand drawn by the Customer exceeds the amount set in Paragraph 4.4 of the Agreement without prior Company authorization. The Excess Demand charges shall be the same as those provided in Scheduled E-56 as follows:

Secondary Service:	\$45.89 per kW
Primary Service:	\$43.52 per kW
Transmission Service:	\$31.73 per kW"
