PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

By Procedural Orders dated October 10, 2007 and November 22, 2007, the Arizona Corporation Commission's ("Commission") Hearing Division established a procedural schedule and set this matter for hearing to commence April 28, 2008. Pursuant to the established schedule, the Staff Report is due March 7, 2008 and the Company's Response to the Staff Report is due March 26, 2008.

On March 3, 2008, Diablo Village Water Company ("DVWC") filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule, reporting that the Company had reached an agreement in principle with the Metropolitan Domestic Water Improvement District ("MDWID") for MDWID to acquire all of the assets of DVWC. DVWC states that it contacted the Commission Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") prior to filing its Motion and Staff's counsel authorized the Company to represent that Staff supports the Motion.

The circumstances warrant granting the Motion. Any party may file a request to have the matter re-set for hearing in the event the anticipated sale of assets does not materialize.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the procedural schedule and **hearing** in this matter shall be suspended indefinitely pending further Order.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **timeclock** for a final order in this matter shall also be suspended indefinitely.
