**STAFF'S MOTION FOR A PROCEDURAL
ORDER REGARDING SERVICE OF
DOCUMENTS**

This Motion is submitted as Staff's request that the Presiding Officer consider issuing a Procedural Order authorizing Parties to provide service of testimony, pleadings, and other documents in this docket by electronic means. As the Administrative Law Judge and other Parties are aware, the Pre-filed testimony that has been submitted in this matter has been quite voluminous. Additionally, Staff anticipates that subsequent pleadings or testimony in the proceeding may continue to be voluminous. This Motion is submitted in hopes of providing an efficient, cost effective means of communicating among the Parties to this proceeding.


Staff's suggestion is that Service of all subsequent pleadings, testimony, or other documents in this matter be accomplished by electronic means. Where an email address of a Party is known, Staff would propose that documents be emailed to that known email address. If no email is known for a particular Party, Staff would propose that Service be accomplished by either mailing a printed copy of a document, or by mailing a disk containing an electronic version of the document. Staff would propose that electronic versions of documents be sent in either "Word" or ".pdf" format, at the sender's option.

1 Finally, Staff notes that the Commission's Docket Control Office is not equipped to treat
2 electronic versions of documents as the original. Accordingly, Staff would propose that Parties
3 continue to be required to submit an original and 13 copies of any filing, in printed form, to Docket
4 Control in order to fulfill filing requirements. In addition, any Party who prefers to receive printed
5 documents should be permitted to do so. Accordingly, any Party who wishes to receive printed
6 copies of documents in lieu of an electronic version, should be required to docket and serve a request
7 for such treatment in the Docket. No Procedural Order should be required to grant such a request.
8 Rather, any Party so requesting should be automatically entitled to receive Service of documents in
9 printed copy instead of in electronic form. In the absence of such a request, service of an electronic
10 version of a document should be deemed to comply with service requirements.

11 Staff respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge issue a Procedural Order
12 consistent with this Motion.
