

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE LETTER OF CREDIT**

11 Applicant Triplet Mountain Communications, Inc. ("Triplet") hereby respectfully
12 requests an extension of fourteen (14) days within which to file its required irrevocable sight
13 draft letter of credit ("Letter of Credit") with the Arizona Corporation Commission.

14 On December 21, 2007, the Arizona Corporation Commission (the "Commission")
15 unanimously approved the Opinion and Order in this matter, which was designated as Decision
16 No. 70101 (the "Decision"). Finding of Fact No. 23.c. of that Decision required Triplet to file
17 its Letter of Credit with the Commission's Business Office within 30 days of the effective date
18 of the Decision.

19 Although the Decision was signed and docketed on December 21, 2007, Triplet and its
20 counsel did not receive copies of that Decision until January 2, 2008.

21 Since that time, Triplet has been engaged with its bank, Bank of America, to obtain the
22 necessary Letter of Credit. However, due to delays in that process, Triplet will be unable to file
23 the Letter of Credit within the 30 day deadline, which expires today.

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Based upon representations by the Bank, Triplet fully expects to have the required Letter of Credit issued within the next ten to twelve days. Therefore, Triplet respectfully requests that the deadline for filing the Letter of Credit under Finding of Fact 23.c. of the Decision be extended for a period of fourteen (14) days, through and including February 5, 2008.

Triplet is not yet providing any services authorized under the Decision and will not do so before the Letter of Credit is filed.
