PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 28, 2006, IPC Network Services, Inc. ("IPC" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold point-to-point private line telecommunications services in Arizona.

On June 5, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Letter of Insufficiency and first set of data requests in this matter.

On July 5, 2006, IPC filed its response to the data request.

On June 4, 2007, IPC filed updated information in response to Staff's data requests.

On June 26, 2007, Staff filed its Staff Report recommending approval of IPC's application.

On October 19, 2007, by Procedural Order, this matter was set for hearing to begin on November 29, 2007.

On November 23, 2007, IPC docketed proof of publication in accordance with the Procedural Order issued in this matter. Subsequently, counsel for IPC contacted the Hearing Division stating the Applicant would be requesting a continuance in this matter.

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1 On November 29, 2007, public comments were taken in this matter, and the evidentiary
2 portion of the hearing was continued.

3 On November 29, 2007, Applicant filed a Motion to Continue the hearing. Subsequently, a
4 Procedural Order was issued on December 7, 2007, which continued the evidentiary portion of the
5 hearing until January 22, 2008.

6 On December 7, 2007, Staff filed a Staff Report Amendment, stating that it was no longer
7 requesting a hearing be held in this matter.


8 On December 19, 2007, by Procedural Order, Applicant was directed to file a response to
9 Staff's recommendation that a hearing not be held in this matter.

10 On January 8, 2008, Applicant filed its response stating that it did not desire a hearing in this
11 matter.

12 On January 22, 2008, the hearing in this matter was convened. Based on Staff's
13 recommendation and Applicant's response that no hearing be held in this matter, the hearing in this
14 matter was vacated and the matter was taken under advisement pending submission of an Order to the
15 Commission.

16 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing set for January 22, 2008, is hereby vacated
17 and the matter will be taken under advisement pending submission of an Order to the Commission.
