**SUPPLEMENT**

Lightyear Network Solutions, LLC (“Lightyear”), through its undersigned counsel, hereby file this supplement to Docket Nos. T-04229A-03-0915 and T-04229A-07-0642 to provide clarification to its previously filed Application for Approval to Partially Surrender Its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, filed on November 8, 2007 (“Application”). Lightyear clarifies that, to the extent necessary, the Application should also be considered as a request to amend Decision No. 69171, in the manner described below.

Lightyear submits the following additional information in support of the Application:

1. Lightyear was certified by the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) in Decision No. 67435 to provide competitive resold and facilities-based local exchange and resold and facilities-based long distance services in Arizona. As part of that certification, on December 5, 2006, in Decision No. 69171, the Commission ordered Lightyear to submit a performance bond or letter of credit in the aggregate amount of \$135,000. As the text of Decision No. 69171 makes clear, the amount of the letter of credit was derived from three amounts based on the specific type of service to be provided. Specifically, the \$135,000 total was comprised of a \$10,00 bond for resold long distance service, \$25,000 bond for resold local exchange service and \$100,000 bond for facilities-based local exchange services.


2. On November 8, 2007, Lightyear submitted the Application, to surrender of its resold and facilities-based local exchange certificate. Simultaneously and under separate cover, Lightyear submitted the \$10,000 bond required to provide resold long distance service. As described in the Application, Lightyear has no intention of providing resold and facilities-based local services in Arizona. As such, in order to demonstrate compliance with Decision No. 69171 and to move forward with its provision of services, Lightyear hereby respectfully requests that, as part of a decision reached in response to the Application, the Commission amend this docket and Decision No. 69171 to remove the requirement to file a \$25,000 bond for resold local and \$100,000 for facilities based local exchange services.
