PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 23, 2007, North Mohave Valley Corporation ("NMVC") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide water service in Mohave County, Arizona.

On August 22, 2007, Staff filed a Letter of Insufficiency in this docket indicating that NMVC had not met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C").

On August 27, 2007, NMVC filed an amended legal description.

On August 30, 2007, NMVC filed Proof of Publication.

On September 19, 2007, NMVC filed its Response to Staff's Insufficiency Letter.

On October 16, 2007, Staff filed a Sufficiency Letter in this docket, indicating NMVC's application had met the sufficiency requirements set forth in the A.A.C.

On October 30, 2007, by Procedural order, the hearing in this matter was scheduled for December 13, 2007, and other procedural deadlines were set.

On November 1, 2007, Staff filed a Motion to extend the deadline for filing its Staff Report from October 30, 2007, to December 17, 2007. Staff requested the additional time to ensure that the Staff Report would provide the Commission with the information and analysis it would need in order to evaluate the issues raised in this proceeding.

1 On November 16, 2007, by Procedural Order, Staff's Motion to extend the deadline for filing
2 its Staff Report was granted and other procedural deadlines were reset.

3 On November 30, 2007, NMVC informed the Hearing Division that Notice of the December
4 13, 2007 hearing date had been mailed to the property owners in the proposed extension area and
5 published in a newspaper of general circulation.

6 On November 30, 2007, by Procedural Order, the hearing originally set for December 13,
7 2007, was reset to commence on January 31, 2008, and the time clock was extended in this matter.

8 On December 13, 2007, a public comment session was held; however, no members of the
9 public appeared to give comments.

10 On January 31, 2008, the evidentiary portion of the hearing was held. At the conclusion of
11 the hearing, the parties were directed to file late-filed exhibits regarding testimony given during the
12 hearing. This Procedural Order is being issued to govern the filing of those late-filed exhibits.

13 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **Staff shall docket a copy of the Approval of**
14 **Construction issued by ADEQ** that was submitted to Staff by NMVC prior to the hearing, on or
15 before **February 18, 2008**.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Staff shall docket a copy of the Commission Decision**
17 **granting NMVC Section 33** as discussed during the hearing, as well as provide an analysis
18 discussing whether NMVC has met all conditions contained in that Decision, on or before **February**
19 **29, 2008**.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **NMVC shall file its most recent Compliance Status**
21 **Report from ADEQ** showing that its water system is within acceptable maximum containment
22 levels for arsenic, nitrates and fluorides, on or before **February 29, 2008**.


23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **NMVC shall file documentation from Bullhead City**
24 **showing the City will provide sewer service** in the proposed extension area, on or before **February**
25 **29, 2008**.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock in this matter is extended accordingly.

27 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
28 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
2 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
3 hearing.
