On February 11, 2008, Qwest LD Corp. ("QLDC") filed an application to increase a monthly fee associated with an obsolete calling plan, Qwest Choice Long Distance, Docket No. T-04190A-08-0030. - STF 1.1 Please confirm that this filing seeks to increase the Maximum Monthly Rate per Line rate rather than Maximum Monthly Rate per Account as stated in the cover page of the tariff filing.
- STF 1.2 Please provide a statement setting forth the reasons for which a rate increase is required. Refer to R14-2-1110(B)(1) of the Arizona Administrative Code ("AAC").
- STF 1.3 A decision has not been reached by the Commission in Generic Docket, Docket No. RT-00000J-05-0329, In the Matter of the Generic Investigation of Tariffing and Notice Requirements for Combined Interstate and Intrastate Calling Plans. Does QLDC agree, therefore, that Commission rules for maximum rate increases apply in this matter? If no, please explain QLDC's position.
- STF 1.4 Please indicate if there is a cost based justification for the rate increase (i.e., is the rate increase necessary to account for a change in your cost)? If yes, please describe the change in your costs. Provide calculations and data to support your cost justification.
- STF 1.5 How many customers were mailed the Exhibit 1 customer notice included with the January 14, 2008 application?
- STF 1.6 Did Qwest receive any written responses from customers regarding the Exhibit 1 customer notice? If yes, please provide copies of all written responses.
- STF 1.7 Does the number of customers impacted by this filing still equal the figure provided to Staff via email on January 22, 2008? If yes, please indicate if the figure must be treated as Confidential. If no, please provide the appropriate information and indicate if the figure must be treated as Confidential.
- STF 1.8 What is the number of lines corresponding to the number of customers in the above response? Also, please indicate if the figure must be treated as Confidential.

- STF 1.14 Does QLDC believe customers will change to other long distance providers as a result of the proposed increase? If yes, please provide an estimate for the cost that individual customers might incur for moving to other long distance providers.
- STF 1.15 Please provide the estimated % increase in QLDC intrastate revenues associated with this filing and explain if the % should be treated as Confidential.
