**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO
INTERVENE OF SOUTHWEST
ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROJECT**

17 Pursuant to the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Arizona Corporation Commission
18 (“Commission”), Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (“SWEEP”) hereby petitions for leave to
19 intervene in the above-captioned docket and, in support thereof, state as follows:

20 1. SWEEP is a non-profit public interest organization promoting greater energy
21 efficiency in six states in the Southwest including Arizona. SWEEP seeks to promote the
22 development of energy efficiency programs, rate design reform, distributed generation resources
