- **Cost of preparing the Joint Report:**

\$15,107.70. This figure represents the engineering time spent to prepare the Joint Report. These amounts are included in the total estimates provided by Verizon in the Joint Report.

- **Estimated costs of removing existing overhead facilities and salvage value of those facilities:**

Estimated removal costs: \$44,756.64.

Estimated salvage value of the removed facilities: \$ 8,420.24

- **The remaining undepreciated original cost of the existing overhead communications facilities.**

Verizon has used the net book value for the existing overhead facilities for this calculation. The net book value of the existing overhead facilities is \$698.55.
