

PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE HEARING FOR ANTELOPE LAKES SEWER, L.L.C., FOR A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (DOCKET NO. SW-20510A-07-0062)

On January 29, 2007, Antelope Lakes Sewer, L.L.C. ("Applicant") filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide sewer service to various parts of Yavapai County, Arizona.

The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona and at the Applicant's office, 2465 W. Shane Drive, Prescott, Arizona.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter commencing on **March 27, 2008 at 9:30 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

- 1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
- 2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of Applicant, a shareholder of Applicant, a competitor, etc.)
- 3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **March 14, 2008**. If representation by counsel is required by Rule 31 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. For information about requesting intervention, visit the Arizona Corporation Commission's webpage at <http://www.azcc.gov/utility/forms/index.htm>. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.

If you have any questions or concerns about this application or have any objections to its approval, or wish to make a statement in support of it, you may write the Consumer Services Section of the Commission at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007 or call 1-800-222-7000 or appear at the hearing and make comment.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
