BY THE COMMISSION:

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Shared Communications Services, Inc. ("Company") has a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Arizona pursuant to Decision No. 60570 (January 14, 1998) ("Decision").
2. On January 27, 2006, the Company filed with the Commission an application ("Application") for cancellation of its Certificate. The Company indicated that it never had customers in Arizona.
3. On March 16, 2006, the Company filed an Affidavit of Publication indicating that it published legal notice of its Application on March 6, 2006, in the *Arizona Republic* in compliance with Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-2-1107(B).
4. On May 1, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Letter of Insufficiency and First Set of Data Requests ("Data Requests").
5. On May 14, 2006, the Company filed its Responses to the Data Requests.
6. On November 8, 2007, a Procedural Order was issued requesting Staff to file an

1 update on the status of this docket.

2 7. On December 7, 2007, Staff filed its Staff Report recommending cancellation of the
3 Company's Certificate.

4 8. According to the Staff Report, the Company's 2005 and 2006 Annual Reports filed
5 with the Commission's Corporations Division noted that the Company had no customers in Arizona.

6 9. In the Decision, the Company was not required to obtain a performance bond, and in
7 its Responses to the Data Requests, the Company indicated that it did not collect any advance
8 payments, deposits and/or prepayments from customers.

9 10. The Company does not have any employees or facilities in Arizona.

10 11. The Commission's Consumer Services Section of the Commission's Utilities Division
11 reported that there were no customer complaints, inquiries or opinions against the Company from
12 January 1, 2004 through May 21, 2007.

13 12. The Corporations Division reported that the Company is in good standing.

14 13. Because the Company has never had customers in Arizona and never collected any
15 advanced payments, deposits and/or prepayments, the provisions of A.A.C. R14-2-1107(A)(2)-(4),
16 provision to customers of a list of alternate providers and a plan for refund, are hereby waived.

17 14. Given the foregoing, Staff's recommendation is reasonable.

18 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

19 1. The Company is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the
20 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

21 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Company and the subject matter of the
22 application.

23 3. The cancellation of the Company's Certificate is in the public interest.

24 4. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue decisions regarding
25 Certificates of Convenience and Necessity for certain telecommunication services without a hearing.

26 5. Staff's recommendation is reasonable and should be adopted.

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
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
ORDER
