ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Telecom Resources, Inc. ("Company") has a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold local exchange and resold long distance telecommunications services in the State of Arizona pursuant to Decision No. 61172 (October 8, 1998).

2. On November 8, 2007, the Company filed with the Commission an application for cancellation of its Certificate ("Application"). The Company indicated that it has never provided service in Arizona and has no plans to do so in the future. No customer notice regarding the Application was provided.

3. On November 16, 2007, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Letter of Insufficiency and First Set of Data Requests ("Data Requests").

4. On December 18, 2007, the Company filed its Responses to the Data Requests.

5. On January 8, 2008, Staff filed its Staff Report recommending cancellation of the

1 Company's Certificate.

2 6. Staff verified that the Company does not serve the Arizona telecommunications
3 market and has not collected any advance payments, deposits, and/or prepayments and has no
4 customers. As such, and because there exist in Arizona other competitive local exchange carriers,
5 Staff recommended approval of the Company's Application to cancel its Certificate.

6 7. The Commission's Consumer Services Section of the Commission's Utilities Division
7 reported that there were no customer complaints, inquiries or opinions against the Company from
8 January 1, 2004 to the present.

9 8. According to the Staff Report, the Commission's Corporation Division stated that the
10 Company was not in good standing because of issues with its 2007 Annual Report.

11 9. Because the Company has never had customers in Arizona and never collected any
12 advanced payments, deposits and/or prepayments, the provisions of A.A.C. R14-2-1107(A)(2)-(4),
13 and (B), requiring provision to customers of a list of alternate providers, a plan for refund, and notice
14 of the cancellation to customers, are hereby waived.

15 10. Given the foregoing, Staff's recommendation is reasonable.

16 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

17 1. The Company is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the
18 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

19 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Company and the subject matter of the
20 application.

21 3. The cancellation of the Company's Certificate is in the public interest.

22 4. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue decisions regarding
23 Certificates of Convenience and Necessity for certain telecommunication services without a hearing.

24 5. Staff's recommendation is reasonable and should be adopted.

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ORDER




IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
